Good day!

A year has already passed, time surely flies! A year ago, in June 2017, we produced our first cement at the plant. Today, it is with great pride that I share this company's update with you.

Production and Sales: we continue to Ramp up!

We have reached important milestones in the last few months. Since last April, the plant produces at least 100,000 tons of clinker as well as 100,000 tons of cement monthly. Gradually, as we planned, we are moving towards our nominal capacity, it's coming soon! Our team does a great job, every day!

Sales are just as exceptional. Our customers' testimonials speak for themselves: the quality of our product is undeniable, and McInnis is already a reference in the industry.





The customers who try our product adopt us, come back, increase the quantities ordered: it is quite positive for our future as a company. They are also very impressed by our distribution facilities in Canada and the United States, where we load their cement trucks. They describe them as fast, clean and friendly. In fact, in the coming days, we will commission our last maritime

terminal in the Bronx, in the heart of the New York market. The photos above show the large warehouse built in the Bronx, and the cement loading silos.

You have probably heard in recent weeks about our environmental evolution. We are continuing to work on biomass, a type of fuel that could be integrated into our operations that would help us further reduce our environmental footprint. We also announced the creation of

the Gaspésie Clean Tech Pole, an organization that will analyze innovative technological solutions that could be added to the plant. This will allow us both to continue the work in environment and to generate new business opportunities for the area.

We will keep you informed of the progress!







BY-LAW NUMBER 2013-04

REGARDING DOGS

Article 9: Nuisance:

The following facts, circumstances, actions and acts are nuisances and are, as such, prohibited, and the keeper himself who is the author of such nuisance or whose animal acts in such a manner as to constitute such nuisance, contravenes this regulation and is Subject to the penalty imposed by this Regulation:

Any dog yapping, groaning or emitting sounds in such a way as to disturb the peace or to be a serious annoyance to the neighborhood;

Any dog pursuing, attacking or injuring a pedestrian, cyclist or other domestic animal;

The presence of a dog without a guard outside the limits of the property of the keeper;

The fact for a dog to bite, to try to bite a person or an animal;

The presence of a dog without a guard, not kept on a leash by his keeper, outside the property of the keeper;

The presence of a dog without a keeper, on the property of the guard, when the dog is not attached or the keeper's property is not sufficiently fenced to contain the dog;

The presence of a dog on a playground of the municipality or in a building of the municipality with the exception of guide dogs;

The presence of a dog on private land without the consent of the occupant of that land;

The refusal by the keeper of a dog to allow the competent authority to enter his home to observe compliance with this Regulation.
