### Word from the Mayor

Dear citizens,

The year 2018 is coming to an end! Several municipal files and projects occupied us throughout the year. One of the most important files was without a doubt the evaluation of the cement plant, which, I must admit, ended with the most positive and appreciate note. The McInnis Cement industrial complex is valued at + or - \$180 million, which translates into property tax entry of + or - \$2.1 million for the year 2019. To that, we add + or - 1.5 million for the years 2017 and 2018.

The Gascons water and sewer project has also evolved significantly. Government financial assistance for eligible costs increased from \$11 million to \$26 million, which allowed us to go out to tender for professional services for the design of plans and specifications for construction. Submissions will be open on January 21<sup>st</sup>.

Another file that is being implemented is the conversion of the former Port-Daniel arena into a municipal garage and fire station. Recently, we received confirmation of financial assistance of \$2.3 million on a project cost of \$3.3 million. The refurbishment work is scheduled in January 2019. The development and paving of the land (parking and access road) will be done this summer.





Several improvements to our municipal roads took place during the year and will continue during the next year. Among other things, we will mark our streets and the sidewalks will be redone.

We had a very good summer season with, among other things, our musical shows on our public stage, the festival that was a real success and our beach volleyball tournament, which was very much appreciated by the public and the athletes who attended. Our municipality is doing well and the future looks bright. In January, we will adopt our budget and several other projects will be part of our discussions and will be put forward during the year, among others, the project for the senior's residence, the repairs of the wharfs at l'Anse-à-la-barbe and Port-Daniel, the extension of the Multifunctional Center or the renovation of the old convent, etc.

With that, I join the members of the municipal council and the employees of the municipality to wish you a very nice Holiday Season and a very Happy New Year 2019.

Winter has settled in early this year, hasn't it? At the plant, we learned a lot from the harsh winter we had last year. As soon as the cold season arrived, we saw a major increase in our operations compared to a year ago. Our team has worked to significantly reduce the effects of cold weather on our operations, I am pleased with this improvement. We still have some wintering work to complete, but so far, I am more than satisfied with those recent cold weeks



#### **Biomass and Clean Tech: in Action!**

Over the last few months, we have taken important steps for two major initiatives that we hold dear and for which we put a lot of effort and energy. First, the feasibility study on the use of biomass in launched! It will allow us to clearly identify our needs, to set up a potential supply chain and an efficient logistics circuit. We strongly hope that this study confirms that forest biomass could be used in our process as a source of combustion, which would allow us to significantly reduce our greenhouse gas emissions, while creating dozens of new jobs in our region.

For its part, the *Pôle des Technologies propres de la Gaspésie* – the Cleantech Cluster – announced the hiring of their general manager, Mr. Guy Pardiac, who assumed his new role in the middle of the Fall. The organization founded last Spring by your municipality, the Rocher-Percé and Bonaventure MRCs, the Gaspésie–Îles-de-la-Madeleine Regional Environmental Council as well as McInnis, will seek to identify the best technological solutions that could lead to reducing our environmental impact, through carbon capture. Our cement plant already has the lowest footprint per tonne of cement produced in its industry, and our intention is to maintain our leading position and leadership in this regard. The *Pôle* will help us achieve this goal and we are very satisfied with the organization's first steps.

Regulation reminder concerning the maintenance of winter roads



for motor vehicle traffic

### **Article 5: Snow Deposit**

During the snow removal of parking lots, driveways entrances or private properties, no one may deposit this snow near the fire hydrants, on roads and roads maintained by the municipality in such a way to encumber the roadway or to reduce the width road.

### **Article 6: Parking forbidden**

It is strictly forbidden to park any motor vehicle within the right-of-way of municipal roads, as well as in the routes at the end of these roads and paths, in order not to interfere with the snow removal operations that are carried out there. Any vehicle so parked will be towed at the expense of its owner.

### **Article 7: Offender to the regulation**

Is liable to the penalties laid down by the regulation, anyone who prevents or harms the work of the municipality or of his representative or anyone who contravenes any other article set out in the regulations.


### Tips for properly managing the outage situation

- make a list of emergency numbers, including the number of **Hydro-Québec** (1 800 790-2424) to dial to report a failure.
- Have a battery-powered radio so you can follow the evolution of a major breakdown situation.
- Prepare an emergency kit and stored it in an easily accessible location. Check the contents regularly so that it is always complete and in working order.
- Provide a battery-powered flashlight in your emergency kit to avoid the use of candlesthese may pose a fire hazard.
- Plan a backup energy source or temporary accommodation for someone living in your home who needs a survival device.
- Download the Hydro-Québec application to follow the evolution breakdowns and stay informed through notifications.

### Quebec waste reduction week.. a great success!

- Nearly 400 students came to visit the sorting center during the week!
- The young people saw with their eyes the equipment, the good gestures to make to facilitate the work of the sorters
- our employees exchanged a lot with them, answered their questions
- and Saturday ...90 citizens came to meet us
- the most frequent questions :
- o les questions les plus fréquentes

What do we do with the plastic bags? We put them all in the same transparent bag (the bread bag for example) and put it in the blue bin

o small pieces of paper, plastic metal...can we put them in the blue bin ? YES because we have our line of cleaning of rejects which allows us to recover the lids of cans, caps, the small pieces of glass

Shredded paper? Help us and put it in a transparent bag...it will be easier to sort

### The participation rate in the Brown bin...a small stimulus is necessary!

• There is a decrease in the rate of participation in the Brown bin so a few reminders

o on our territory, participation in the Brown bin rates vary between 25 and 50 % (PDG = 33 %, Chandler = 53 %, GR = 49 %, STE-T = 49 % et Percé = 26 %)

o in comparison, in Gaspe, they maintain a rate of 70-80% since June

o the fall and winter, a large brown paper bag ...no disadvantage (no flies or little worms!) It's a good time to start.

o a 30 % increase in the participation rate = 200 000 \$ savings


