#### WORD FROM THE MAYOR

Dear citizens,



After a most vigorous winter, spring has finally arrived! This brings us to talk about the great spring cleaning and the cleanliness of our municipality. In the coming weeks, our employees will be busy cleaning up the streets, sidewalks, ditches and around our infrastructure. We will deploy men and equipment to ensure the cleanliness of our public space. But a municipality's level of cleanliness also depends on everyone's efforts. The cleanliness of the municipality is everyone's business and that is why we invite you to help make our village more enjoyable and attractive.

Another topic, just as important and interesting, that I would like to share to you, concerns the finances of our municipality. After verifying our books of account for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018, I am announcing that we are starting 2019 with an unallocated surplus of \$ 1,777, 898,plus an allocated surplus of \$ 204 338, for a total of \$ 1, 982, 236. You will understand that the result of this surplus comes from Cement McInnis's tax revenues and more specifically from its progressive evaluation for the years 2017-2018. We can therefore tell you that the financial situation of our municipality is, to date, excellent, despite the fact that we still have to be careful while continuing to invest in the improvement and development of our municipality. To this end, several projects are in progress, either on the drawing board, in the process of being completed or in requests for financial assistance.

With that, I join the members of the municipal council and the employees of the municipality to wish you a very happy Easter and a very good season to our fishermen and plant workers as well as to our merchants, entrepreneurs and workers of all kinds!

## A Word from Alexandre Rail, McInnis Cement's Vice President-Operations

Good day!

After the harsh winter we have just experienced, which came to visit us again in force early April; it is with great joy that we see the arrival of Spring! It will be a good season for us, as well as a very busy one!

## A lot of environmental and economic action!

The *Pôle des technologies propres de la Gaspésie* – the Cleantech Group, founded almost a year ago, is really taking off! Two employees are now working full time and are increasingly integrating with the regular activities of our teams at the plant. By sharing knowledge about our process and our ways of doing things, the Group will develop its autonomy and will be able to play its advisory role in clean technologies that can be added to our facilities and help us reduce our overall environmental footprint.



The Group and McInnis will also participate in an industrial visit mid-April, in Europe, to find out more about biomass drying technologies that we could annex to the cement plant, thereby reducing our GHG emissions by 150,000 tonnes per year. This tour was organized by the forest biomass feasibility study team, which is still going well and upon which we have great hope. And let us remember that if we succeed in attaching a project of this type, either with biomass or other clean technologies, we will contribute to the installation of new businesses and the creation of new jobs. Once again, an ambitious goal, and we are ready to take up this challenge.

A few words, in closing, on the repair of the railway. Work is progressing well along the stretch between Port-Daniel and Caplan, and the Ministry of Transportation has also begun planning repairs to the rock outcrop just east of the plant. The deadlines are being maintained by the new government in place, so on our side, we are going to start thinking about our own rail yard and car loading to be ready when the rail is back on track. We still have a few years ahead of us before this materializes and we are certainly heading in the right direction!
