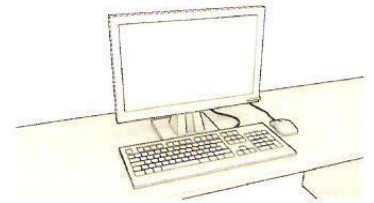

Word of mayor

Dear citizens,



In this municipal newsletter, I would like to inform you about some of the municipal issues that concern us on a daily basis.



In the matter of drinking water supply and wastewater treatment in the Gascons sector, our engineering consulting firm is at the stage of preparing the plan and specifications. Given the scope of the proposed network, this work is rather laborious and should last until the end of July 2020. After that, we will move to the tendering stage for the start of construction.

In the case of the conversion of the former arena into a municipal garage and fire station, work has started since January and should be completed by the end of July, including the development of the community hall and paving of the parking lot and access roads.

In the case of the renovation and expansion of the Multifunctional Center, the OPR firm is in the process of preparing the call for tenders for the work to be done. The projected works are for the existing center; a new exterior cladding, a new entrance, new windows and some interior improvements. In addition, we are planning an expansion of the multi-purpose center to accommodate some organizations as well as parking improvements.



In the case of the seniors' residence, the project was submitted to the Société d'Habitation du Québec. An agreement has been reached for the purchase of a new piece of land located on the 132.

In the case of the l'anse à la barbe wharf, Fisheries and Oceans Canada is expected to open a call for tenders at the end of June and work is to be completed by May 31, 2020.





In the reconstruction of the wharf at the cultural and family space, the plans and specifications are completed and we are waiting for certificates of authorization from the ministries of environment and wildlife to launch the call for tenders.



An amusement park is in the preparation stage at the former ball field, Captain Fournier Road. Several games will be installed there for the pleasure of the youngest.

A playground will be installed at our municipal arena for the spring and summer seasons.

We commissioned the firm CLDesing for the renovation plans for the Centre Plein Air La Souche. A cost estimate will also be submitted to us and thereafter we should call for tenders for the improvement work.

The two digital screens will be installed before the end of June. This is an excellent information tool for our activities.

We will continue the work begun to improve our municipal streets (asphalting, marking, slides, lighting and sidewalks).

Finally, we do not forget the feast of St-Jean-Baptiste, which this year will be celebrated in the cultural and family space. . The Quebec band Les Torrieux and a singer will be there and a small bonfire and fireworks will enliven the evening.



Music Wednesdays, the Rock'n Ride festival and the Beach Volleyball Tournament will entertain us during the summer months. The day camp for our kids ages 5 to 12 is back this year.

Finally, I join the members of the municipal council and the employees to wish you a very nice summer!

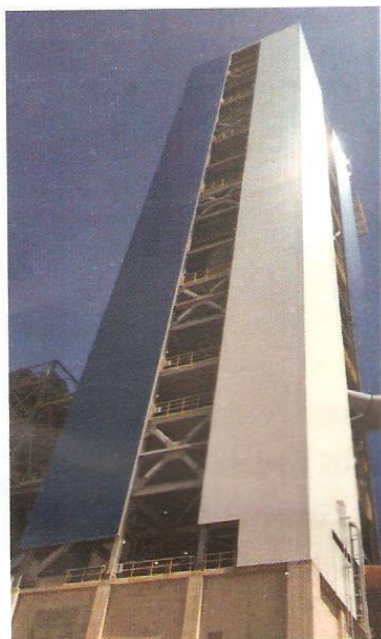

100% of organic matter valued for 2022?

The government has implemented measures to address the major issues of waste management. One of the measures that results is the program of treatments of organic matter by biomethanisation and composting. This program aims to:



- Reduce the amount of organic material destined for disposal in order to promote the achievement of the environmental objectives set out in the Québec Residual Materials Management Policy
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions to contribute to Québec's objectives in the fight against climate change

The program's initial objective was to have 60% of organic materials recycled by the end of 2015 and 100% of these by 2020. However; the government has revised its targets to 60% by the end of 2018 and 100% by 2022. Concretely to comply with the objectives and requirements of the Government of Quebec, this means that in 2022, 100% of organic materials will have to be valued. No organic matter will have to go to landfills and every home will have to have a brown bin.

Are we close to the 100% target for 2022? Currently, no accurate data can confirm this, but knowing that only about 30% of municipalities offer the collection of organic materials, we can imagine the answer.

All citizens, businesses, organizations, we will have to ask ourselves about our way of consuming, to have a responsible consumption and a good management of our residual materials is the starting point. Reducing our waste and organic matter at the source is a collective goal.
