REGULATION

TRAILERS, CONTAINERS

AND OTHER TYPES OF PROHIBITED BUILDINGS

Please note that there is a regulation that governs the use of transport facilities used for other purposes.

This regulation stipulates, among other things, that any vehicle or means of transport, in working order or not, such as carriage of railway, bus boat, truck, container, trailer or other vehicle the same nature are prohibited to house-the-people or to serve as-a-main or accessory building.

This regulation is applicable throughout the territory of the municipalities of Port-Daniel-Gascons, Chandler, Grande-Rivière, Sainte-Thérèse-

de-Gaspé and Percé. Anyone who contravenes these provisions commits an offence and is liable to a fine.

WORD FROM THE MAYOR



Dear citizens,



As in the previous bulletin, I would like to inform you about the major municipal projects that are either being completed or in the process of being completed.

In the matter of drinking water supply and wastewater treatment in the Gascons sector, the work of preparing the plans and specifications is well

underway and deadlines are being met.

In the case of the conversion of the former arena into a municipal garage and fire station, the work is almost complete and you will be invited to the official inauguration that will take place next September.





In the case of the renovation and expansion of the Multifunctional Center, we are currently calling for tenders and bids will be open on September 5th.

In the file of the residence for seniors, I inform you that the 24 housing units have been retained by the Quebec Housing Corporation (SHQ). Water flow tests and soil tests have been carried out and we are awaiting the results. It's a promising project.

In the case of l'Anse-à-la-Barbe wharf, we are finalizing the legal aspects of the return of infrastructure to the municipality and work will begin this fall.



in the file of the renovation of the wharf at the cultural and family space, the opening of the bids is scheduled for August 28th. In terms of the installation of floating docks, we are at the plan and estimate stage.





We opened the municipal amusement park on Captain Fournier Road, although the work was not completed. These are expected to be completed in the fall and everything will be ready for next season. Tennis fans seem to enjoy it and appreciate our court.

The municipality is currently acquiring the Center Plein Air La Souche. Major renovations will be carried out there and we have been confirmed that we can use the money from a government program (return of the gas tax) for the full cost of the work.

The municipality's digital screens have been installed. Recently, we have been marking our municipal roads. For those who were not marked, this was due to their narrowness that made the work impossible.



Coming soon, it will be the 2nd edition of our tournament— L'open de volleyball gaspésien. More than 65 teams are registered and partici pate in the event on August 23-24-25. With the sun at the rendezvous, it will

be a sure success.

The Rock N Ride festival was held last July and the comments are very positive. Once again, thank you to the organizing committee and the volunteers! Our musical Wednesdays are always appreciated and the last show will take place on Wednesday, September 4th.

Finally, I join the members of the Municipal Council and employees in wishing you a very nice end of the summer season.

A Word from Alexandre Rail, McInnis Cement's Vice President-Operations

Good day!

Let me take a few moments to thank all of those who came to meet us at the plant last month, during the open house. With the help of twenty members of our team who agreed to share their experience and knowledge on a volunteer basis, we were able to welcome nearly 450 visitors in one afternoon! For many of them, it was their first contact with our impressive facilities. The photos show the enthusiasm that was palpable during this beautiful day. I was also very happy to be able to count not only on the help of our employees but also on the presence of a few partners with whom we work in close collaboration, namely the employees of the Cleantech Pole and the project manager of the biomass study currently underway. It was a great opportunity to talk with you about McInnis' environmental footprint reduction projects that these professionals are piloting with us.



You may have seen news in the media about a major refinancing operation of our company, in the order of \$ 500 million of private capital from our shareholders and banks. This is an important step that McInnis has taken in July, which shows the confidence of our investors in the project. These sums will be injected throughout the company, especially at our terminals to increase our warehouse and truck loading capacity to meet our customers' demand for our products. Here, on the plant side, we expect significant work this fall with the construction of two new cement silos to add to the existing four. At the peak of this project, 200 construction workers will be active on site. In addition, McInnis must prepare for the return of the rail to the plant, which is expected around 2022. We must adapt our facilities to allow direct loading of railcars on our site as well as develop our own rail yard. The return of the train to the plant will significantly reduce truck movements, most of which are directed to the New Richmond transloading station. We are preparing for much more action in the coming months!
