#### **April 6, 2020**

Information about the Port-Daniel-Gascons Council meetings in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic!

Considering that the government has declared a state of emergency for an indeterminate period;

Considering that the government allows the municipal council to sit behind closed doors and authorizes council members to participate, deliberate and vote in a meeting by any means of communication and this in the interest of the public to avoid gatherings and thus protect the health of the population;

Consequently, be advised that the Municipality of Port-Daniel-Gascons, for an indeterminate period, will hold any council meeting behind closed doors and that the public will not be admitted to these sessions, but it will still be possible to ask questions by joining the Mayor at 418-751-3156 on regular business hours!

#### **April 8, 2020**

Following information from our governments, the Coronavirus pandemic (Covid-19) is not over! We will feel its negative effects again for the next few weeks and months!

#### MUNICIPAL SERVICES

All municipal buildings, including librairies, community centres, sports and recreations centres are cloded to the public. Most city halls are closed, although employees will still be providing essential services to te population. In order to limit the spread of COVID-19, municipal employees will answer by phone, rather than in person.

Your municipalities are working to ensure that the preventive measures recommended by the government are implemented through the sharing of information, education, and by listening to their citizens. Several municipalities have already announced the preventive measures they have implemented. Support services are in the process of being set up, and municipalities will be adapting their services to reflect these new preventive measures

### POPULATION ALERT SYSTEM IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

#### WHAT?

The Municipality of Port-Daniel-Gascons, in partnership with the municipalities of the MRC, have signed a service agreement for the implementation of the "Web Memento Urgence" application, which allows citizens to register to a mailing list to receive alerts from municipal authorities when a so-called urgent situation arises.

#### WHY?

The municipality of Port-Daniel-Gascons will be able to send alert messages via text or SMS on cell phones to inform or alert in case of emergency breakdowns or disasters such as:

- ⇒ Notices of non-consumption of water
- ⇒ Boil water advisories
- ⇒ Evacuation notices
- ⇒ Power outages
- ⇒ Or any other emergency

The municipality will be able to target a particular area or the general population to advise them of the situation and what action to take.

For this alert to be effective, you need to be registered with the automated alert system to receive messages.

#### **HOW TO REGISTER?**

In order to receive alerts from municipal authorities when an emergency arises, go to the https://mmnto.ca/fr, select civil security and fill all the requested fields. Works only with a cell phone number or email address.

#### A Word from Alex Wojciechowski, McInnis Cement's Chief Operative Officer

#### Good day!

The situation we all live in is unique. I hope you are well and that you can adapt to the new confinement rules related to the COVID-19 pandemic. McInnis Cement operates an industrial complex whose operation with reduced staff is authorized by the government. Let me explain how we proceeded with the various necessary adjustments at the plant.

#### Telework and Hygiene and Sanitation Measures

As of Friday, March 13, McInnis sent home all of its employees who were able to work remotely: this concerns all employees at the head office in Montreal, all our sales representatives in Canada and the United States, but also a good part of our employees located in Port-Daniel who provide administrative work. We already had in place a variety of digital tools to keep us connected and are just as efficient when working from home as if we were in the office. The transition was fairly easy and allows us to count on our workforce despite the circumstances.

Enhanced hygiene and sanitation precautions have been implemented in all our locations — in addition to frequent hand washing and physical distance, we have also added one way-corridors in the administrative building to avoid meeting colleagues too closely as well as imposed capacity limits in our meeting rooms. Our employees are very rigorous in applying the rules and their collaboration is essential to allow us to maintain operations by reducing the risk of spread as much as possible.

The number of workers at the site has dropped considerably. By stopping the construction of silos 5 and 6 and terminating the contracts of several subcontractors, the number of people accessing the plant daily has decreased by about 75%. They are mostly McInnis employees, with very few exceptions, in particular SanHy Pro employees who continue to ensure the cleaning of our space with additional measures adapted to the current situation, and their usual professionalism. We thank them very much.

#### New Procedures Throughout the Company

In addition to measures of hygiene and physical distance, as well as teleworking and operations with reduced staff, we have adapted a panoply of procedures in our daily operations to limit, even outright cut all physical contact between our employees and our partners. Truckers, for example, do not come into direct contact with anyone when they pass through our terminals. The same is true for ships: their crews are confined to the ships and there is no contact with our teams on land. Some « paper » operations are now digital, again, to avoid contact.

We will be happy to return to a normal situation, wish it to happen quickly. Until then, take care of yourself and yours!

# BORROWING SETTLEMENT NUMBER 2020-02 DECREEING AN EXPENSE OF \$ 1,607,000 AND A LOAN OF \$857,000 FOR THE RESURFACING OF ROADS RIVER, CHENEL, DE LA PRÉE AND CLEMVILLE

**WHEREAS** the notice of motion in this regulation was duly given at the council meeting of April 14, 2020 and that the proposed regulation was tabled at that same meeting.

Mireille Langlois, seconded by Mr Denis Langlois and resolved that the council decrees the following:

- **ARTICLE 1.** The preamble is an integral part of these regulations.
- ARTICLE 2. The council is authorized to carry out the resurfacing work on the River, Chenel, Prée and Clemville roads, according to the plans and specifications prepared by Tétra Tech QI Inc. numbered 39438TT as of March 2020 and the detailed estimate prepared by the Acting Director General, Ms. Marlyne Cyr, dated April 14, 2020, which are an integral part of this regulation as Appendices "A" and "B».
- **ARTICLE 3.** The council is authorized to spend an amount of \$ 1,607,000 for the purposes of this regulation.
- **ARTICLE 4.** For the purpose of paying for expenses under this regulation, the council is authorized to borrow \$857,000 over a period of 15 years.

- ARTICLE 5. The council is authorized to effect annually during the term of the loan, a portion of the general revenues of the municipality to cover expenses incurred in relation to interest and the capital repayment of the annual maturities of the loan in accordance with article 1072 of the Municipal Code of Quebec.
- **ARTICLE 6.** If the amount of an allocation authorized by this Regulation is higher than the amount actually spent in connection with that allocation, the council is authorized to use that surplus to pay for any other expenses decreed by this Regulation for which the allocation would be insufficient.
- ARTICLE 7. The council allocates to the reduction of the loan decreed by this regulation any contribution or subsidy which may be paid to it for the payment of part or all of the expense decreed by this regulation.
- ARTICLE 8. The Mayor and the Acting Director General are authorized to sign for and on behalf of the municipality, all documents or contracts necessary to carry out the work mentioned in the provisions of this regulation.
- **ARTICLE 9.** This regulation comes into force in accordance with the law.

## RESOLUTION 2020-04-115 COVID-19 – CANCELLATION OF EVENTS AND OTHER GATHERINGS CULTURAL AND SPORTING

**CONSIDERING** that the Quebec government is requesting the cancellation of festivals as well as public, sporting and cultural events in Quebec for the period up to August 31, 2020;

**CONSIDERING** the need to respect the physical distance measures of 2 meters;

**CONSIDERING** that gatherings are prohibited;

THEREFORE, it is proposed by Mr. Denis Langlois, seconded by Mr. Marc-Aurèle Blais and resolved;

That the municipality of Port-Daniel-Gascons cancel all cultural and sporting events, indoor and outdoor for the summer period.

Unanimously adopted by councillors

EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROJECT AND CIVIL SECURITY

in need of special assistance in an emergency.

#### **ASSEMBLE AN EMERGENCY KIT**

The following list can help you assemble a proper kit make sure you're well prepared

- $\Rightarrow$  Water
- ⇒ Non-perishable food
- ⇒ A manual can opener
- ⇒ A flashlight (cranked or battery powered and spare batteries)
- ⇒ Duplicate car and house keys
- ⇒ A first aid kit
- ⇒ Money in small denominations
- ⇒ Items for special needs (medication, infant formula)
- ⇒ Personal hygiene items
- ⇒ Important family documents (birth certificates, marriage, passports, permits, wills, property deeds, insurance)
- ⇒ A copy of your emergency plan

#### **OTHER ITEMS**

- ⇒ Spare clothing and shoes
- ⇒ Scissors / penknife / whistle
- ⇒ Toilet paper
- ⇒ A multi-purpose tool or basic tools

It is important to store supplies in the same place in a sturdy bag that is easy to carry in case of an emergency (such as a backpack).
