NEW! Garbage collection every three weeks

Why increase garbage collection to every third week?

- Reduces operational costs
- · Will increse participation in recycling and composting
- Prevents the collection of near-empty containers (however, take out your compost container regularly to avoid odours).
- To prepare for the implementation of unit-based pricing in 2024

ATTENTION! Our inspectors are authorized to verify individual containers placed curbside to ensure compliance with regulation No. 328-2020 regarding waste management.

What to do if my garbage container is full?

- Sort your waste properly. Only true waste should be thrown in the trash, not recyclable or compostable materials
- Bring your construction waste, electronic products, paint and other recyclable materials your nearest eco-center.

Can I request a second garbage container?

 No, only one garbage container is permitted per household, unless special permission is granted.
 No recyclable material should be found inside.

How may I obtain a brown or blue container?

- Brown (compost): Contact us at 418 385-4200
- Blue (recycling): Can be purchased at your local hardware store. Call us to provide the serial number.

In Winter

Place your bin at a distance of approximately 10 feet from the white line to prevent damage from the snowplow.

7.5.4.2 ATTACHED PRIVATE GARAGE

Notwithstanding the minimum distances prescribed in the table, in the case of semi-detached or row dwellings, an attached garage may be located along the adjoining lateral line of the land provided that it is paired respectively with another garage of the same architecture and located on the adjoining lot.

The provisions specified in the following tables for each additional building must be complied with:

7.5.4.3 PRIVATE GARAGE

Maximum number allowed per land	1	
Maximum area	Whichever is more restrictive, i.e. 80% of the floor area of the main building or 100 m ²	
Maximum height	6 m	
Establishment authorized in	Front, rear and side yards It must respect the front setback prescribed from the building and cannot be located in the projection of the façade of the main building facing the street	
Minimum distance from side or rear lines	1 m	
Mimimum distance from a another building (main or complementary)	2 m

Minimum distance is measured from the foundation wall of the detached garage. Notwithstanding the minimum distances prescribed in the table. In the case of semi-detached dwellings, a detached garage may be located along the adjoining lateral line of the land, provided that the land is twinned respectively with another detached garage of the same architecture and on located on the adjoining land.
