### Public address to all qualified voters in the municipality

#### PUBLIC NOTICE IS GIVEN

# QUALIFIED VOTERS ENTITLED TO BE ENTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST OF THE ENTIRE MUNICIPALITY

- 1. At a meeting of the Council held on 2022, december 12, the City Council of Port-Daniel-Gascons adopted by-law number 2022-08 entitled: by-laws 2022-08 décreeing an expenditure of 9 156 000\$ and a loan of 8 000 000\$ to carry out repair and expansion work on the Marco-Sébastien-Cyr Sport Center, replacing and repealing by-laws number 2022-04 and 2022-06.
- 2. The qualified voters entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the municipality may apply that by-law number 2022-08 be the subject of a referendum vote by entering their name, address and capacity and by signing in a register opened for that purpose.
  - Qualified voters wishing to register their name must present identification: health card, driver's licence, passport, certificate of Indian status or Canadian Forces identification card.
- 3. The register will be accessible from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on 2022, december 19 at the office of the municipality of Port-Daniel-Gascons, located at 494, road 132, Port-Daniel.
- 4. The number of applications required for the Regulation number 2022-08 be the subject of a referendum vote is 223. If this number is not reached, the regulation number 2022-08 shall be deemed approved by qualified voters.
- 5. The result of the registration procedure will be announced at 7:05 p.m. on 2022, decembre 19, at the office located of Port-Daniel-Gascons, at 494, road 132, Port-Daniel.
- 6. The regulation may be examined at the office of the municipality of Port-Daniel-Gascons, every working day from Monday to Thursday, from 8:30 am to 12 pm and from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

Conditions to be a qualified voter entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the entire municipality:

- 7. Any person who, the 2022, december 12 is not incapacitated from voting under section 524 of the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities and meets the following conditions:
  - be a natural person domiciled in the municipality and have been domiciled for at least 6 months in Québec and;
  - be of legal age and Canadian citizenship and not be under curatorship.
- 8. Every sole proprietor of a building or sole occupant of a business establishment who is not incapable of voting and
  - have owned an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment located in the municipality for at least 12 months;
  - in the case of a natural person, be of legal age and Canadian citizenship and not be under curatorship.
- 9. Any undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment who is not unable to vote and meets the following conditions:
  - have been an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment located in the municipality for at least 12 months;
  - be designated, by means of a power of attorney signed by the majority of the persons who have been co-owners or occupants for at least 12 months, as the person who has the right to sign the register on their behalf and to be entered on the referendum list, if applicable. This power of attorney must have been produced before or when the register was signed.

## 10. Moral person

have designated by resolution, from among its members, directors or employees, a person who, on 2022, december 12 and at the time of exercising this right, is of full age and of Canadian citizenship, who is not under curatorship and is not incapacitated by law to vote.
