Gaspe women / In tribute to Elles

Half the world is a woman! Gaspésie is feminine! However, it does not always appear. HISTORY is about the Amerindians, Jacques Cartier, Charles Robin, Théodore Jean Lamontagne, etc.. Who are these little-known Gaspé women? Like the chatelaine of the Middle Ages, they manage the estate and finances while the gentleman has gone far away. They built the country. Historian Jean-Marie Thibeault reminds us of this.



**HAZEL (JOURNEAUX) MCCALLION
FORMER MAYOR OF MISSISSAUGA
DIES AT AGE 101**

Born (February 14, 1921) in the Gaspé Community of Port-Daniel, her father Herbert Armand Journeaux owned a fishing and cannery company and her mother, Amanda Maude Travers, acted as a housewife and managed the family farm.

A student in Montreal, Hazel played hockey on a professional team. Having learned to play during the 1920s in her hometown, she played for a salary of \$5 per game in a team sponsored by Kik Cola playing in a three-club league.

She met her husband, Sam McCallion in 1951 and married him the same year. She and her husband founded a newspaper called the Streetsville Booster in 1964. The couple had three children. In 1977, Sam died of Alzheimer's disease.

After several years at Kellogg Canada where she quickly climbed the ladder, she decided to enter politics. First elected mayor of the Village of Streetsville in 1969, she went on to serve as mayor of the newly amalgamated city of Mississauga (Streetsville and Port Credit, from 1978 to 2014. She was mayor of Mississauga for 36 years. Until 2014, McCallion was constantly re-elected without the risk of being dislodged by an opponent serious enough to take her place. Nicknamed "Hurricane Hazel" for her political style, McCallion was considered a trailblazer for women in the field. She remained active in the public sphere until the end of her life. She passed away peacefully on January 29, 2023 at her home in Mississauga.

From the top of her little 5 feet, this lady continues to maintain the quiet strength made of courage that makes her the feminine legend of Gascons.

At a young age, she sketched out her future with the desire to listen to her community.

By choosing teaching as a profession, she spent more than 30 years collaborating in the academic development of students. She initially experienced multi-level classes and will end her career at the Polyvalente. She contributed greatly to the recommendations of the Parent Commission of the 60s.

To the expression "Who takes husband, takes country", for Camellia, we will say: "Who takes husband, takes family". If the house is big, his heart is doubly big. She and her husband Lionel will continue the family line with their 2 children, Patrice and Caroline.

The welcome that characterizes her combined with the listening to the needs of the families of Gascons, encourage her to take the reins of the family business. Many people, after walking through the door of the grocery store, will come away satisfied and surprised that a person still has so much availability and concern for good customer service.

If she had to suddenly leave family and commerce to quickly go to church, it was to join either the choir or the pastoral. And she will simply say that it was another good opportunity to serve her own.

A few times, the disease knocked on his door. By overcoming the various pitfalls of her life so worthily, she remains for all of us an attractive example of tenacity and courage.

The breath of life that Madame Camellia animates, she nourishes it with all her humility.

On this Women's Day, what could be more beautiful example of feminine strength?

Zoning By-law, 2017-06, chapter 7, s. 7.3

Chapter 7

USES, BUILDINGS AND COMPLEMENTARY CONSTRUCTIONS

7.3 STANDARDS SPECIFIC TO INTERGENERATIONAL HOUSING COMPLEMENTARY TO HOUSING

Intergenerational housing is permitted in all areas subject to compliance with the following standards:

(1) intergenerational housing is reserved for persons who are related or have an affinity relationship with the owner or occupant of the principal dwelling, namely the spouse, common-law partner, their dependants, parents, grandparents, etc. ;

(2) intergenerational housing is authorized as a complementary use only in zones where detached single-family dwellings are authorized under this Regulation on the following conditions:

(a) only one intergenerational dwelling per dwelling is permitted;

(b) it must be directly connected to the principal dwelling,

i. through a door inside the main dwelling;

ii. from the outside by an entrance door separate from the main entrance door, either on the rear wall or on a side wall. This separate entrance must be integrated into the architecture of the building without changing its single-family character;

(c) in the case of an expansion to add an intergenerational dwelling, it must harmonize with the general architecture of the building, in particular with regard to the materials used;

(d) the residence must have a single civic address, a single electric meter and, where applicable, a single septic system

(e) the intergenerational dwelling may be located in the basement, ground floor or upper floor. If it is located in the basement, the height of the finished floor to ceiling must be at least 2.10 m.

(f) the other provisions of the planning by-laws must be complied with, including access and parking standards.

(3) intergenerational housing must be planned taking into account the temporary aspect of the dwelling. Therefore, if the occupants of the intergenerational dwelling leave permanently, it must remain vacant, be occupied by the owner-occupant or by new occupants who meet the criteria established under this Regulation. The owner or occupant of the principal dwelling must inform the municipality of any change in the occupancy of the intergenerational dwelling.
