In the case of aqueduct and sewers file, in the Gascons sector, everything is taking its course and we expect to issue a call for tenders during the next winter.

ILLEGAL CONNECTION TO THE PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM

RECALL-RECALL-RECALL-RECALL

The purpose of this reminder is, that a volume of water too high of illegal drainage in the pumping stations, cause overflows.

EXTRACTED FROM REGULATION NO. 2014-05 CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATION OF WATERWORKS AND SEWER SYSTEMS

Article 5: Requirement for a connection to sewers (sanitary or rain):

5.1 Every owner of a building served by the municipal sewer service must install, at his own expense and maintain in good working order, a safety valve (no-return valve) to prevent any back-up of sewage.

5.5 In the event of failure by the owner to install and maintain such valves (nonreturn valve) in good condition in accordance with this by-law, the municipality is not liable for damage caused to the building or its contents as a result of a sewer water backup.

Article 6: Protection and maintenance of water and sewer equipment

6.4 It is strictly forbidden to connect any basement drain or storm drain to the public sanitary sewer system.

Article 7: Supervision

7.4 The officers of the municipality responsible for the water and sewer service shall be entitled between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. to visit any immovable property as well as the interior and exterior of any building served by the said networks in order to ascertain the condition of the piping and the appliances connected to it and to see if the water is not wasted, make a census or for any other cause related to the water and sewer





Place your emergency kit in an easily accessible place. Check its contents annually and replace batteries and water supplies as needed, as well as non-perishable foods.

Here are the 7 essential items to have in your emergency kit:

- ✓ Drinking water (6 liters per person)
- ✓ Non-perishable food (for at least 3 days)
- ✓ Manual can opener
- ✓ Battery-operated radio with spare batteries
- ✓ Headlamp or flashlight spare batteries or hand-cranked lamp
- ✓ Lighter or matches and candles
- ✓ First aid kit (antiseptics, analgesics, adhesive bandages, sterile gauze compresses, scissors)

Enhanced by:

- Duplicates of car and house keys
- Money in small denominations
- Special needs items (medication, infant formula)
- Personal hygiene items
- Important family documents (birth certificates, permits, wills, etc.)
- A copy of the emergency plan
- > The list of contact details of the persons to be contacted in case of emergency

In extra

- A change of clothes and shoes
- Scissors, a penknife, a whistle
- Toilet paper
- A versatil tool or basic tools
