A family snowshoeing daytime activity will be organized during spring break. Detailed programming will be mailed in February.

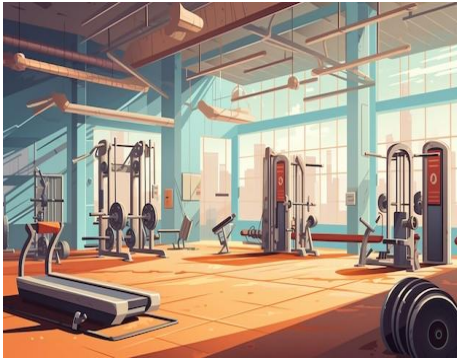

Chapitre 11

ENTREPOSAGE EXTÉRIEUR

Règlement de zonage, chapitre 11, article 11.2

11.2 ENTREPOSAGE D'UNE ROULOTTE DE CAMPING, D'UNE ROULOTTE, D'UN BATEAU DE PLAISANCE OU D'UNE REMORQUE

L'entreposage d'une roulotte de camping, d'une roulotte, d'une remorque ou d'un bateau de plaisance est autorisé sur un terrain sous réserve du respect des dispositions suivantes :

- 1° l'entreposage est effectué en cour latérale ou en cour arrière à au moins 2 m des lignes de lot ;
- 2° le véhicule entreposé possède une immatriculation valide et est en état de fonctionner sur la route ou sur l'eau ;
- 3° un seul véhicule de chaque type peut être entreposé sur un terrain appartenant au propriétaire des véhicules entreposés ;
- 4° l'entreposage doit être effectué sur un terrain où est situé un bâtiment résidentiel ;
- 5° l'entreposage doit être effectué dans la cour arrière ou dans les cours latérales du terrain ;
- 6° la roulotte ne doit pas être une source de pollution ou de nuisance ;
- 7° la roulotte ne peut être reliée à un réseau public de distribution d'électricité ;
- 8° la longueur du véhicule entreposé ne doit pas excéder 9 m ;
- 9° toute construction ou aménagement permanent et accessoire à une roulotte ou véhicule récréatif tels que : galeries, pavage, remise, plate-forme, piscine, spa, jeux, clôture sont prohibés. De plus, une roulotte ne peut servir d'habitation sur une base temporaire ou permanente, être connectée à un service d'aqueduc ou d'eau potable sous pression, ni à un réseau d'égout ni à un système d'évacuation et de traitement des eaux usées.

Rappel du règlement
concernant l'entretien des chemins d'hiver
pour la circulation des véhicules automobiles



Article 5 : dépôt de la neige

Lors du déneigement des stationnements d'entrées charretières ou autres propriétés privées, nul ne peut déposer cette neige près des bornes d'incendie, sur les routes et chemins entretenus par la municipalité de façon à en encombrer la chaussée ou à en réduire la largeur carrossable.



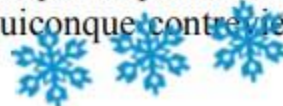
Article 6 : stationnement interdit

Il est formellement interdit de stationner tout véhicule automobile à l'intérieur de l'emprise des routes et chemins municipaux ainsi que dans les virées aménagées au bout de ces routes et chemins afin de ne pas nuire aux opérations de déneigement qui y sont effectuées. Tout véhicule ainsi stationné sera remorqué aux frais de son propriétaire.

NB: Une attention particulière sera portée dans les routes donnant accès à un bâtiment sportif.

Article 7 : contrevenant au règlement

Est passible des pénalités édictées par le règlement quiconque empêche ou nuit au travail de la municipalité ou de son représentant ou quiconque contrevient à tout autre article énoncé au règlement.

- Place your bin approximately 10 feet from the white line, back from the curb.
