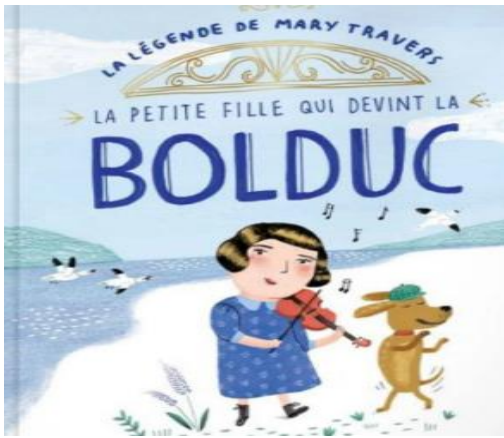

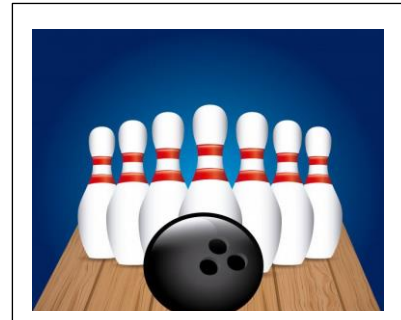

Collection guidelines

- 1** Leave a two-foot clearance around the bin (between a fence, a car or even another bin).
- 2** Write your street address on each of your bins. (This will help us to correctly identify them).
- 3** Take out your bin the day before scheduled pickup. Why? Because the truck can pass as early as 6 a.m.
- 4** Ensure that no materials are sticking out or are on the ground next to the bin.
- 5** If there are two collections on the same day, place the brown bin so that it will be seen first by the driver
- 6** Wheels pointing towards the house.
- 7** To find out how to proceed in case of damage, call us or visit our website ritmrg.ca as soon as you notice the problem.
- 8** Placed at a maximum distance of 10 feet from the white pavement line, neither on the sidewalk nor on the street.
- 9** Put out garbage or recycling bin only when it is full.
